ADMISSION

Admission will be made to F. Y. B. A. / B. Com., S.Y. B.A./B.Com., & T.Y. B.A. / B. Com. in the academic year 2021-2022.

RULES OF ADMISSION:

- 1) **A)** Students who have passed Standard XIIth Examination of Maharashtra Board of Secondary Education in Arts & Commerce stream or equivalent will be admitted to the First Year B.A. / B.Com. course.
- B)** Students seeking admission to the First Year Degree class in this College must attach the following certificates to their application forms:
 - i) Original Junior College Leaving Certificate.
 - ii) The Original Statement of Marks of std. XIIth with two photo copies duly certified by the head of institution.
 - iii) Character Certificate.
 - iv) Certificate for Caste. (In respect of reserved category.)
- C)** Students seeking admission to First Year B.A. / B.Com. must submit the enrolment form duly filled in and pay the Enrolment Fees at the time of admission.
- 2) All admissions are provisional subject to the approval of the University of Mumbai.
- 3) Every student should fill the prescribed admission form and pay the prescribed fees at the beginning of the year and within the prescribed time period.
- 4) At the time of admission, seats are reserved for the backward class candidates as per Government norms. However, if the adequate number of candidates from backward classes do not seek admission to the College within prescribed time period, the vacancies will be filled

with candidates from Non-SC/ST/NT/OBC candidates.

- 5) A student of this College who has qualified himself/herself for admission to the next higher class will be admitted to such a class only if an application for the same in the prescribed form is received with the prescribed fees within the prescribed time.
- 6) Students coming from other affiliated college of this University are required to produce their Transfer Certificate from the previous college. Such students are required to apply through the college office and to pay the prescribed fee in the college office. However, it is entirely the responsibility of the concerned student to obtain the Transfer Certificate from the previous college and submit it to the office of this college.

Applicants from other Universities Statutory Boards seeking admission to this college must produce the following documents with their application.

- I) Certificate of Passing Qualifying Examination.
- ii) Provisional Eligibility Certificate granted by the Registrar, University of Mumbai. (The application for the Certificate of Eligibility must be made within one week of the commencement of the term direct to the Registrar on a prescribed form with the necessary documents and with a fee of Rs.125/- except in the case of students from a University in the State of Maharashtra for whom the fee fixed is Rs. 100/-) Students can be admitted provisionally at their own risk on the strength of the Provisional Eligibility Certificate. They should also produce: I) Transfer Certificate, ii) Migration Certificate, iii) Marks Statement. (Original with two photo copies each.)

- 7) A student once admitted in the first term will be considered as duly enrolled for the second term also, unless he/she informs in writing his / her intention of leaving the college before the beginning of the second term. Students who fails to give such information before the opening of the second term will be required to pay the full fees for the second term.
- 8) A student admitted in one faculty can change the faculty only before the end of August of the first academic year.
- 9) Repeaters of the college will not be permitted as regular students. They will be permitted to appear for examination as ex-students.
- 10) Information regarding Original Certificates submitted at the time of admission must be entered in the admission form at the appropriate place and the original certificates must be collected from the college office by the student before the closing of the college in the summer vacation.

REFUND OF FEES

0.2859 : Refund of Tuition, Development and all other fees after cancellation of admissions :

The candidates who have taken admission in aided and unaided courses conducted by affiliated colleges and in recognised institutions may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation. The percentage of fees for the course shall be refunded to the candidate after deducting charges as follows :

PERIOD AND PERCENTAGE OF DEDUCTION CHARGES

- i) Prior to commencement of academic term and instruction of the course.

Deduction Charges : Rs. 400/- Lumpsum.

- ii) Upto 20 days after the commencement of academic term of the course.

Deduction Charges : 20% of the total amount of fees.

- iii) From 21 days upto 50 days after the commencement of academic term of the course.

Deduction Charges : 30% of the total amount of fees.

- iv) From 51 days upto 80 days after the commencement of academic term of the course or August 31st whichever is earlier.

Deduction Charges : 50% of the total amount of fees.

- v) From September 1st to September 30th

Deduction Charges : 60% of the total amount of fees.

- vii) After September 30th

Deduction Charges : 100% of the total amount of fees.

Note : The total amount considered for the refund of fees from the commencement of academic term of the courses includes the following :

- i) All the fee items for one year (excluding tuition fee for the second term) mentioned in the revised fee structure for Arts, and Commerce faculties vide University circular No. CONCOL/FE/190 of 2003 and in case of course under other Faculties, the total amount is as fixed by other competent authorities of Government of Maharashtra.
- ii) The fee component out of all fee in the column number ii, iii and iv (e.g. from commencement of academic term upto August, 31st) includes the following items in the deduction charges :
 - Tuition Fee (of the first term only), Library Fee, Gymkhana Fee, Other Fees, Extra Curricular Activities Fee, Students Welfare Fund, Utility Fees, Development Fund, Computer Practical Fee and E-charge.
- iii) In addition to the above, for the period of September 1st to 30th (column No. V) the following terms are also included:
 - Industrial Visit, Vice-Chancellor Fund, Project Fee, University Sports and Cultural Activities and Group Insurance.
 - Fee Collected for Identity Card and Library Card, Admission Form and Prospectus and Enrollment and any other course specific fee are not refundable after the commencement of the academic term.
 - The fee collected against the particulars of Magazine, Examination and Projects be fully refunded for cancellation before September 30th.
 - A refundable deposits (Caution Money and Library etc.) shall be fully returned at the time of cancellation.

iv) Wherever admissions are made through centralized admission process for professional and / or for any other courses by other competent Authorities of Government of Maharashtra, the Refund Rules are applicable as specified by such authorities (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year of admission and in case of admission to subsequent years of the course is applicable for cancellation of admission.

A) A fees paid by a student at the time of admission shall be refunded to him / her deducting Rs. 250/- (Rs. Two Hundred Fifty Only) as administrative charges provided :

(i) At the time of applying for admission, he/she intimates in writing, that he/she has also applied or intends to apply for admission to some other course too in one or more college or institutions or departments of this University which impart instruction for courses of the University.

And

ii) He/she withdraws his / her application in writing within seven days from the date of his/her admission to college or course, but not later than 31st August of the same academic year. In such cases it shall be binding on the student to produce documentary proof of his/her being admitted to some other course of different college/institution.

B) A fees paid by a student at the time of admission shall be refunded to him/her deducting a lump sum of Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five Hundred Only) as administrative charges provided :

(i) At the time of applying for admission, he intimates in writing, that he/she has also applied or intends

to apply for admission to some other course too in one or more colleges or institutions or departments of this University which impart instruction for courses of the University.

And

- ii) He/she withdraws his / her application in writing within seven days from the date of his/her admission to a course between the period from 1st September and 30th September of the same academic year. In such cases it shall be binding on the student to produce documentary proof of his/her being admitted to some other course of different college/institution.

Note:- Students applying for Scholarship, Free Studentships should note that these are given on the following conditions: -

- i) That applicant is regular in attendance.
- ii) That his/ her conduct and progress are satisfactory.
- iii) That he/ she submits completed application forms with the required documents within prescribed time.
- iv) Students eligible for admission under reserved category (S.C, S.T., V.J., N.T., S.B.C., O.B.C.) may secure admission with payment of require fees.

Application will not be accepted after the notified date of the University.

RULES FOR COLLEGE DISCIPLINE:

- 1) The College attaches great importance to discipline and the same must be maintained by all students.
- 2) Failure to comply with any of the rules, regulations or requirements notified from time to time will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- 3) Students must always keep with them the Identity Card issued to them by the college with their recent photograph affixed on the same bearing the signature of the Principal. They must present it for inspection or verification when demanded by any of the College Authorities. No students shall be allowed to attend lectures, tutorials, etc. unless he / she have his / her Identity Card with him/her.
- 4) Students must attend all classes, tutorials and seminars according to the Time-table. Absence at any of these classes without the permission of the Principal may lead to loss of terms.
- 5) Students must not attend classes other than their own without the special permission of the professor concerned.
- 6) Students should make use of the college library or the common-room and must not loiter in the college premises whenever they have a free period. They should not disturb the work of the college.
- 7) Students must be in their classes in time. Late-comers will not be allowed to enter the classes.
- 8) Students must do nothing either inside or outside the College that will in any way, interfere with its orderly administration and discipline. They should not communicate any information or write anything about the College to the press or any other organization or persons

without the written permission of the Principal.

- 9) Students are liable to lose their terms for disobedience, misconduct, misbehavior or for any act of serious indiscipline.
- 10) Students must take proper care of the College property. Any damage done to the property of the College by disfiguring walls, doors, windows and fittings or breaking furniture and such other things is breach of discipline and will be punishable as such.
- 11) Smoking, Eating Gutkha, Tobacco are strictly prohibited in the College premises. Anyone found involved in such cases, strict action will be taken as per Govt. Rule.
- 12) **As per Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1999, Ragging is Prohibited. Victims of Ragging can complain to the Principal of college. Those who are found involved in Ragging will be rusticated from College and will not be admitted for next five years in any of the colleges. Also imprisonment with a fine of Rs. 10,000/- may be charged.**

As per University Circular No. SW/02/of 2016 ragging is prohibited.

- 13) No association or organization shall be formed, no meeting held, no person invited to address the students in the college without the previous written permission of the Principal.
- 14) No picnics, social excursion or tours shall be arranged without the previous permission of the Principal, obtained by application in the prescribed form at least one week prior to the date of event. If a student joins an unofficial picnic or tour, the college shall not be responsible for

anything that happens on the picnic or tour.

- 15) No student shall collect money as contribution for picnic, trip, and educational visit to some place, get together, and study notes, charity or any other activity without the prior sanction of the Principal.
- 16) In the college debates and other meetings, the chair must be taken by a responsible person approved by the Principal and the subjects of debates or lectures must have the previous approval of the Principal.
- 17) Indecent language and behavior are strictly prohibited in the College premises.
- 18) Matters not covered by the existing rules will rest at the discretion of the Principal.
- 19) Students joining the college are supposed to accept and observe all Rules and Regulations of the college and to undertake to submit to the normal enforcement of the same to satisfaction of the Principal whose decision in this regard will be final.
- 20) As per the University of Mumbai circular *No. spl-cell/274/ of 2011 dated 9-09-2011*, the college maintains a special complaint register for any caste discrimination in the college campus. The students / employees are requested to register any complaint relating to caste discrimination with the Principal in writing for prompt action.

विद्यार्थी मंडळ - (Students' Council)

१९९४ च्या विद्यापीठ कायदानुसार महाविद्यालयात प्रत्येक शैक्षणिक वर्षासाठी एक विद्यार्थी मंडळ तयार करण्यात येते. या मंडळाचे अध्यक्ष प्राचार्य असून ते निवडणूक अधिकारी म्हणून ज्येष्ठ प्राध्यापकाची निवड करतात. हे मंडळ प्रत्येक वर्गातील प्रथम क्रमांकाने उत्तीर्ण झालेले विद्यार्थी तसेच N.S.S. प्रतिनिधी, सांस्कृतिक विभागाचा प्रतिनिधी, क्रीडा विभागाचा प्रतिनिधी, प्राचार्य नियुक्त दोन विद्यार्थिनी असे ११ प्रतिनिधींचे मंडळ तयार करून त्यांच्यामधून निवडणूक प्रक्रियेने विद्यार्थी विद्यापीठ प्रतिनिधी म्हणून निवडून दिला जातो. या विद्यार्थी मंडळाच्या

व प्रतिनिधींच्या सहकार्याने महाविद्यालयात विविध उपक्रम राबविले जातात. परंतु विद्यापीठ कायद्यात बदल होत असल्याने त्यानुसार विद्यार्थी मंडळ निश्चित होईल.

सहशैक्षणिक उपक्रम :

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना - (National Service Scheme) NSS

१९९४ पासून कार्यरत असलेल्या या विभागातील अनेक विद्यार्थी विविध स्तरावर नेतृत्व करीत आहेत. प्रतिवर्षी १५० विद्यार्थी-विद्यार्थिनींना या विभागात प्रवेश दिला जातो. पथनाट्य, पोस्टर निर्मिती अशा माध्यमातून पोलिओ निर्मूलन, एड्स विषयक जागृती, रक्तदान शिबिर, व्यसनमुक्ती, पर्यावरण संवर्धन अशा अनेक सामाजिक जाणीव जागृती विषयक कार्यामध्ये ही मुले अभिमानास्पद कार्य करतात. दरवर्षी दत्तक गावामध्ये भरणान्या सात दिवसांच्या निवासी शिबिरामध्ये बंधारा बांधणे, स्वच्छता, रस्ता दुरुस्ती, शाळेसाठी क्रीडांगण निर्मिती, विविध जाती-जमातीच्या समस्यांचे सर्वेक्षण करणे अशी अनेक कामे स्वयंसेवकांकडून केली जातात. शिवाय वर्षभरात अनेक प्रकारच्या स्पर्धा, सहली, पदयात्रा याद्वारेही व्यक्तिमत्त्व विकास साधला जातो. जिल्हास्तरीय नेतृत्व प्रशिक्षण शिबिर, राष्ट्रीय एकात्मता शिबिर, मुंबई विद्यापीठ, दिल्ली येथील प्रजासत्ताक दिनाचे ध्वजसंचलन अशा महत्त्वपूर्ण उपक्रमांमध्ये सहभागी होण्याची संधीही गुणी विद्यार्थ्यांना प्राप्त होते. राष्ट्रीय सेवा याजेनेत सहभागी होणाऱ्या विद्यार्थ्यांमध्ये सभाधीटपणा, वक्तृत्व, नेतृत्व व्यवस्थापन व कार्यालयीन कौशल्ये यांचा विकास होतो. मुंबई विद्यापीठाच्या नियमाप्रमाणे समाधानकारकरित्या काम करणाऱ्या विद्यार्थ्यांना १० जादा गुणांचा लाभही होतो. तसेच या अनुभवाचा व प्रमाणपत्राचा नेहरू युवा केंद्र वा इतर स्वयंसेवी संस्थांमध्ये कार्यकर्ता पदासाठीही उपयोग होऊ शकतो.

आजीवन अध्ययन आणि विस्तार विभाग - (Department of Life Long Learning and Extension) DLLE

२०११-१२ या शैक्षणिक वर्षापासून मुंबई विद्यापीठाचा सदर

विभाग प्रथमच महाविद्यालयात स्थापन करण्यात आला आहे. या विभागामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांला अभ्यासापलिकडचे विश्व बघता येते व त्याला जाणीव होते की, महाविद्यालयाची पायरी चढून उच्च शिक्षणाचा लाभ आपल्याला मिळाला. त्यासाठी आपण स्वतः नशिबवान आहोत. या समाजाचे आपण काहीतरी देणं लागतो हे विद्यार्थ्यांला केवळ या विभागामुळेच समजते. या विभागांतर्गत एकूण आठ प्रकल्प राबवले जातात. त्यात प्रामुख्याने एन्.आय.ओ.एस्., डब्ल्यू.एस्.आय.टी.ई.चा समावेश होतो. संपूर्ण वर्षभर प्रथम सत्र प्रशिक्षण, द्वितीय सत्र प्रशिक्षण, आंतरमहाविद्यालयीन पथनाट्य व भिक्तीपत्रक स्पर्धा, पोस्टर्स तयार करणे, वार्षिक स्नेहसंमेलन, 'उडान महोत्सव', लघुनिबंध सर्वेक्षण इत्यादी कार्यक्रम पार पाडले जातात. याद्वारे विद्यार्थ्यांच्या व्यक्तिमत्त्व विकास व नेतृत्व गुणात भर पाडली जाते. तसेच मुंबई विद्यापीठाच्या नियमाप्रमाणे समाधानकारकरित्या काम पूर्ण करणाऱ्या विद्यार्थ्यांना १० जादा गुणांचा लाभही होतो. तसेच या अनुभवाचा फायदा विद्यार्थ्यांच्या सर्वांगीण विकासासाठी होऊ शकतो. कारण यामध्ये काही करियर करता येणारे प्रोजेक्टही आहेत.

मराठी भाषा व वाङ्मय मंडळ - (Marathi Bhasha Va Wangmay Mandal)

महाराष्ट्राची राजभाषा आणि लोकभाषा असलेल्या मराठीचे जतन आणि संवर्धन व्हावे यासाठी मराठी भाषा व वाङ्मय मंडळामार्फत विविध उपक्रम राबविले जातात. विद्यार्थ्यांची वाङ्मयीन अभिरुची घडविणाऱ्या उपक्रमांबरोबर त्यांची भाषिक जाणीव समृद्ध करणे, विद्यार्थ्यांना मराठी भाषेच्या व संस्कृतीच्या मुख्य प्रवाहात आणणे, साहित्येतर व्यवहारक्षेत्रात मराठी भाषेचा वापर वाढवून मराठी ज्ञानभाषेची प्रतिष्ठा प्राप्त करून देण्यासाठी हे मंडळ कार्यरत आहे.

सांस्कृतिक विभाग - (Cultural Depatment)

महाविद्यालयामध्ये विद्यार्थ्यांचा सर्वांगीण विकास व्हावा ही अपेक्षा

जिमखाना विभाग - (Gymkhana)

'शरीर धड तर मन धड' या ग्रीक तत्वाच्या अनुषंगाने विद्यार्थ्यांच्या सर्वांगीण विकासासाठी महाविद्यालयात प्रवेश घेतलेल्या प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी-विद्यार्थिनीचे व्यक्तिमत्त्व विविध अंगांनी घडविण्यासाठी महाविद्यालयाच्या क्रीडा विभागामार्फत क्रीडा उपक्रम राबविले जातात.

वक्तृत्व, निबंध व वादविवाद स्पर्धा विभाग - (Elocution, Essay and Debate)

या विभागामार्फत दरवर्षी महाविद्यालयामध्ये राष्ट्रीय तसेच आंतरराष्ट्रीय पातळीवरच्या ज्वलंत समस्यांचे ज्ञान विद्यार्थ्यांना व्हावे म्हणून सदर विषयांवर वादविवाद स्पर्धांचे आयोजन केले जाते. तसेच कै. हरी तुकाराम खापणे स्मृतिप्रित्यर्थ राज्यस्तरीय आंतरमहाविद्यालयीन निबंध स्पर्धेचे आयोजन केले जाते.

फोरम ऑफ फ्री एन्टरप्राईज मुंबई - (Forum of Free Enterprise, Mumbai)

‘फोरम ऑफ फ्री एन्टरप्राईज मुंबई’ यांच्यावतीने महाविद्यालयीन विद्यार्थ्यांमध्ये अर्थशास्त्रीय जाणीव निर्माण करण्यासाठी ए. डी. श्रॉफ मेमोरियल वक्तृत्व स्पर्धेचे आयोजन केले जाते. यामध्ये प्रथम, द्वितीय व तृतीय क्रमांकाना रोख रु. २५००/-, रु. १५००/- व रु. १०००/- आणि प्रशस्तीपत्र देऊन गौरविण्यात येते.

स्पर्धा परीक्षा मार्गदर्शन केंद्र - (Competitive Examination Guidance Centre)

माजी विद्यार्थी संघटना - (Alumni Association)

महाविद्यालयाच्या शैक्षणिक प्रवाहात सहभागी झालेले विद्यार्थी महाविद्यालयीन शिक्षण संपल्यावर परत आपल्या कॉलेजकडे वळावे या उद्देशाने महाविद्यालयात माजी विद्यार्थी संघटना स्थापन करण्यात आली. आज बहुसंख्य विद्यार्थी या संघटनेचे सभासद आहेत. माजी विद्यार्थी आणि पालक संघटनेच्या माध्यमातून कॉलेजच्या विकासात भर टाकावी या उद्देशाने ही संघटना स्थापन केली.

संशोधन समिती - (Research Committee)

महाविद्यालयातील प्राध्यापक आणि विद्यार्थ्यांमध्ये संशोधनवृत्ती वाढीस लागण्यासाठी संशोधन समितीची स्थापना करण्यात आली आहे. लहान-मोठे संशोधनप्रकल्प हाती घेऊन संशोधन केले जाते. अशा संशोधनाचा समाजाला उपयोग होईल असा दृष्टिकोन ठेवला जातो. संशोधनासाठी लागणारे साहित्य, निधी आणि मार्गदर्शन उपलब्ध करून देण्याचे काम संशोधन समितीमार्फत केले जाते. या विभागामार्फत मुंबई विद्यापीठातर्फे दरवर्षी होणाऱ्या 'अविष्कार' संशोधन महोत्सवात विद्यार्थी संशोधन प्रकल्प सादर करतात.

नियोजन मंच - (Planning Forum)

महिला विकास कक्ष - (Women's Development Cell) WDC

महाविद्यालयात महिला विकास कक्ष कार्यरत आहे. या कक्षामार्फत
